Rules for Annual G4ZMC Portable Competition Memorial Trophy

- 1. The club will organise portable events from suitable locations in the local area.
- 2. The aim is to make as many contacts as you can between 1930 & 2130 local time.
- 3. Any amateur bands and any mode can be used according to a rota set out. This rota will set out allocated times for short sessions on 3.5, 7, 14, 18 & 144 MHz in turn for each group/individual taking part. Participants can operate on the other bands outside these times.
- 4. Members can choose to forego their allocated sessions if they so choose but should inform the organiser of their intention.
- 5. Contacts via repeaters, satellites or the Internet are not permitted.
- 6. The scoring system is based on multipliers which favour the less used amateur bands.
- 7. Each contact builds up a score based on the multiplier

- 8. The aim is to encourage members to use the less used bands during the sessions.
- 9. Log sheets will be provided and participants are asked to complete them and hand in to the organiser at the end of the session.
- 10. The winner will be that person who makes the highest score from the best 2 evenings' contacts.
- 11. The G4ZMC trophy will normally be presented to the winner(s) at the Annual General Meeting.
